Terms & Conditions

The theme for all entries is '**Racial and Religious Harmony In Action**'. Please note that good interpretation of the theme is taken into consideration by the judges.

The selection criteria are based on:

- **Theme relevance**
- **Impact**
- **Creativity**
- **Visual aspect and techniques**

Eligibility

The competition is open to all Primary Schools, Secondary Schools, Junior Colleges and Centralised Institutes students. This competition will also be opened to the general public.

Prizes

There will be 10 winners from each category hence a total of 30 winners. Winners will be notified by email. All prize winners will be interviewed as how the pictures were taken, the settings and where and how it was captured.

The top 10 outstanding artworks from each category chosen by our judges will be displayed in a public exhibition at the "Tanjong Pagar Community Club Art Gallery" for two days.

Winners will also be invited to our official opening on 03 August 2008 and prize awards will be given at the same time.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Before entering the above Photography Competition, please read through these Rules. They contain all the information and criteria for entering this competition.

1.
 - a) All official entry forms (photocopies acceptable) must be submitted together with a 8" by 12" (12" being the longest side) photo and a soft original copy and edited copy (in CD-ROM) of the photo in TIFF or JPEG format. Each print should be individually mounted on a black mounting board. A 2-inch border should be given on ALL sides of the black mounting board. At the back of each board, clearly indicate your full name, NRIC number/Passport number, address, contact number(s), email address, title of entry and a brief description of where and when the picture was taken. The Organiser reserves the right to reject entries with incomplete details.
 - b) The soft copy of the photograph should be submitted at its native resolution with no interpolation applied. Save images as TIFF or JPEG at the highest possible quality setting (e.g. 12 in Photoshop). A text file on the CD should carry your full name and NRIC number.
 - c) All submitted materials are non-refundable. Special care must be made to ensure the soft copies are of good quality for further compilation in a CD. Please keep a copy of the entry form and photo entry for your record purposes.
2. All entries must reach Tanjong Pagar Community Club by mail or in person by the following dates :-
 - **Starting date for submission of actual photo prints** : **01 July 2008 (Tuesday)**
 - **Closing date for submission of actual photo prints** : **23 July 2008 (Wednesday)**

11. The Committee reserves the right to use, reproduce and / or edit the submitted photographs for publicity in conjunction with the promotion, before, during and after the event. No payments will be given for the use of these photographs.
12. Submission of entries signifies acceptance of the rules & regulations of the competition. While all possible care will be taken to ensure the quality of the entries, the Committee assumes no responsibility for any loss of or damage to the entries before, during and/or after the competition.
13. Judges will be appointed by the Committee. The Judges' decision on all matters relating to the competition is final, and no correspondence will be entertained.
